## **Exonian Graduate Scholarships**

Through the generosity of former students of Exeter College, the College seeks to elect:

- Up to one Exonian Graduate Scholar from among students who have been awarded a UKRI Studentship to study for a DPhil within a department in the Medical Sciences Division, at the University of Oxford.
- Up to one Exonian Graduate Scholar from among students who have been awarded a UKRI Studentship to study for a DPhil within a department in the MPLS Division, at the University of Oxford.

Where a suitable candidate is identified, the Scholarship will be awarded in conjunction with a University of Oxford-awarded UKRI Studentship, and together these awards will fund all Course Fees, and a grant to cover living expenses for the DPhil degree.

The successful candidates will:

- be an applicant to the University of Oxford for admission to a graduate degree;
- have an offer of a place to study for a DPhil within the Medical Sciences Division, or MPLS Division, of the University;
- be awarded a UKRI Studentship by the University of Oxford;
- become a member of Exeter College, and commit to remaining at Exeter College for the duration of their course.

### **How to apply**

There is no separate application process for this Scholarship; you simply need to apply for your graduate course by the [relevant January deadline](#).

We will consider all eligible applicants to Oxford for this Scholarship, regardless of whether or not you state Exeter College as your [preferred college](#) on your graduate application form. If we offer you this Scholarship we will also offer you a place at Exeter College, which will take the place of any earlier college offer you may have.
