### SKP Scholarship (Pathak Scholarship)

Following a generous gift made by the late Sri Krishna Pathak, a Friend of the College, Exeter College seeks to elect up to one student to the SKP Scholarship from among students who are ordinarily resident in India and have an undergraduate degree from an institution in India, and who also have an offer of admission to study for a DPhil at Oxford University.

Where a suitable candidate is identified, the Scholarship will be awarded in conjunction with an award from Oxford University's Clarendon Fund, and together the SKP and Clarendon award will fund all Course Fees, and a grant to cover living expenses. An SKP Scholarship is awarded for one year in the first instance, and will be renewable for the remaining years of DPhil fee liability subject to satisfactory academic progress being made.

The successful candidate will:

- be an applicant to the University of Oxford for admission to a DPhil degree, who has been offered a place at Oxford University to read for a DPhil in any subject that would lead to the economic development of India;
- be awarded an Oxford University Clarendon award (the SKP Scholarship will not normally be awarded as a standalone award);
- be ordinarily resident in India;
- have an undergraduate degree from an institution of Higher Education in India;
- become a member of Exeter College and commit to remaining at Exeter College for the duration of their course;
- give an undertaking of their intention to return to India for a minimum of two years after graduation.

### How to apply

There is no separate application process for this Scholarship; you simply need to apply for your graduate course by the [relevant January deadline](#).

We will consider all eligible applicants to Oxford for this Scholarship, regardless of whether or not you state Exeter College as your [preferred college](#) on your graduate application form. If we offer you this Scholarship we will also offer you a place at Exeter College, which will take the place of any earlier college offer you may have.
