



Rivka Carmi Graduate Scholarship

Exeter College, Oxford, in-conjunction with the Ben-Gurion University Foundation (UK), seeks to elect a Rivka Carmi Scholar from among students who have graduated from Ben-Gurion University and who have an offer of admission for a one-year full-time Masters degree at the University of Oxford.

The Rivka Carmi Scholarship is tenable only at Exeter College and is worth the Course Fee associated with the course of study (up to a maximum of £31,538 in 2023-2024), together with a generous living and travel allowance (£17,669 in 2023-2024). The Scholarship is open to any student who:

- is a graduate of Ben-Gurion University of the Negev;
- wishes to study for a one-year, full-time Master's degree at Exeter College, Oxford, and has been accepted into the University of Oxford onto such a graduate course;
- commits to remaining at Exeter College for the duration of their course

How to apply

- Apply directly to Oxford University (www.ox.ac.uk/graduate) for a place on your chosen one-year full-time Masters course, no later than the [relevant January deadline](#);
- State Exeter College as your preferred College on your graduate application form. If Exeter College is not available for your chosen course, make no College preference and inform Exeter College of your application by email (admissions@exeter.ox.ac.uk);
- Notify Ben-Gurion University of the Negev of your application (stavi@bgu.ac.il).

Applicants will hear directly from the University if they have been accepted onto their chosen course, usually by the end of April, and the successful candidate for the Rivka Carmi Scholarship, will be notified by Exeter College that they have been awarded the Scholarship, normally by the end of May.

All eligible applicants who are in receipt of an offer from the University for their chosen course will automatically be considered for the Rivka Carmi Scholarship: no further application is required.
